You might have heard that Good Shepherd College and The Catholic Institute will become a single tertiary organisation from 1 January 2020.

It is very important to understand that what you signed up for will not be changing. The creation of the new Catholic tertiary education provider will not affect the courses you have enrolled in, the qualification you are working towards or your overall learning experience.

Over time, the change will lead to a better resourced and more capable single organisation, which reflects a renewed commitment by the New Zealand Bishops to a strong, adaptable and contemporary Catholic tertiary organisation in Aotearoa New Zealand.

We expect that the Bishops will decide the name of the new organisation in early September. Once decided, we will let you know.
